Cheshire Constabulary look forward to welcoming you to PSUK 2023 10 Mile Road Race. The 2023 Edition will take place on Wednesday 13th September 2023.

The race will take place within the grounds and surrounding roads of Tatton Park, Knutsford, WA16 6SG.

Tatton Park is one of the UKs most complete historic estates. It is home to a 15th Century Tudor Old Hall, Neo-Classical Mansion, 50 acres of beautiful, landscaped gardens and 1000 acres of Deer park. You can't help but be inspired by the glorious views and majestic deer that roam the historic parkland.

RACE COST/ENTRY

Individuals will need to enter via the following link - < <u>PSUK 10 mile Road Race | AV Timing</u> > where entry will be £18 per person.

PARKING

Parking will be situated near the race start, you will be directed on the day once arriving into Tatton park

Entrance to the park will be via the Rostherne entrance, WA16 6SG, do not use the Knutsford Entrance.

Tatton Park Café (Stables Restaurant) will be open 10:00 – 17:00, a couple mins walk from the car park.

All participants and spectators will be allowed free access to the park, as long as you stop and advise the gate staff that you are attending the event. Entrance to the park is from 10am.








REGISTRATION / RACE DETAILS

The race will start at 13:00 with registration from 11:00. The entry fee for the race is £18 per person and requires to be paid in advance. The race is chipped timed, UKA licenced under certificate No. 2023-45988 and officially measured under North of England course number 23/075.



We will not have exclusive access to Tatton Park on the race day so please give due consideration to other site users.






COURSE


The course is an approximate 5-mile fast, undulating loop which will start and finish in the beautiful Tatton Park, the course will start with a 1k loop within the park, before venturing onto the nearby road surrounding Tatton Park, before re-entering the park at the Knutsford gates to continue into the park passing Tatton Mere and Melchett Mere.

A road closure will be in place along the majority of Mereheath Ln, though we do ask that runners keep left on the pavement where there is no road closure, and where no pavement keep to the left side of the road and abide by highway code.

BAG STORAGE

There is a planned bag storage area, by the start finish area, which runners are welcome to use. Although footfall is low this will be at your own risk, however the car park is so close to the race start that it's recommended that valuables are left in vehicles where possible.

TOILETS

There are portaloo toilets on site but no changing rooms. There will also be the use of the facilities within the Stableyard, located a short walk from the start/finish area.

FIRST AID

First aid provisions will be available on the day should it be required and there will be marshalls on the course with radio contact back to the organisers should you encounter any difficulties mid race.

PHOTOGRAPHY

Local running photographer, Steve Bateson, will be taking pictures on the day and these will be available as soon as possible after the event. Race photos will be displayed throughout the evening function, with details to be provided of where you can download these from after the event.

King Street Car Park, Malt St, Knutsford, WA16 6DX - 4 minute walk to the courthouse

Short Stay – 4 hours max – 4hrs £3.20

Princess Street Car Park, Princess St, Knutsford, WA16 6BU - 4 minute walk to the courthouse

Long Stay - 10 hours max - 10hrs £4.40, 6hrs £4.00

The evening do will start at 18:00 for drinks reception, food will consist of a sit down 3 course meal which will start at 18:30 allowing time for food and presentations before the evening fun. The cost for the evening do will be £38 per person.

Food will be followed by a live band who will start at 20:00 through to 23:00 with additional music running through to midnight, the bar will remain open until midnight for those attending and later for guests staying at the hotel.
